RESOLUTION NO. R-2020 _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TAMARAC, FLORIDA, AWARDED RFQ NO. 19-26Q TO AND APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH CPZ ARCHITECTS, INC. FOR THE DESIGN OF SUNSET POINT AND VETERANS PARK RENOVATIONS AT A CONTRACT COST OF 258,705.00, A CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,870.50 (10% OF THE CONTRACT COST) WILL BE ADDED TO THE PROJECT ACCOUNT, FOR A TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET OF \$284,575.50; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens, residents, and staff of the City of Tamarac to maintain and upgrade City recreational and leisure facilities to meet the changing needs and use by City of Tamarac residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2019, the City published RFQ No. 19-26Q for the design of Sunset Point / Veterans Park Renovations, incorporated herein by reference and on file in the office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2019, the City of Tamarac held a Pre-Qualification Conference; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2019, the City received and opened six (6) submittals; and

WHEREAS, an Evaluation Committee, facilitated by the City's Senior Procurement Specialist and comprised of the Parks and Recreation Director, Assistant Parks and Recreation Director, Assistant Public Services Director / Capital Projects Manager, the Senior Project Manager, Public Services Superintendent, Budget Manager, reviewed and

evaluated the submittals; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee evaluated the submittals per RFQ No. 19-26Q and short-listed three (3) firms, CPZ Architects, Inc., ACAI Associates, Inc. and Saltz Michelson Architects, Inc., which were requested to make presentations; and

WHEREAS, based upon the totality of the material and information provided by the vendors, the Evaluation Committee unanimously determined CPZ Architects, Inc. to be the most responsive and responsible proposer, a copy of the Evaluation Summary is attached hereto as "Exhibit 1"; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Services, Director of Financial Services, and the Purchasing and Contracts Manager recommend the City of Tamarac execute an Agreement with CPZ Architects, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Tamarac deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Tamarac to execute an Agreement with CPZ Architects, Inc. for the design of Sunset Point / Veterans Park Renovations, at a contract cost of \$258,705.00, a contingency in the amount of \$25,870.50 (10% of the contract cost) will be added to the project account, for a total project budget of \$284,575.50.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TAMARAC, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1: The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof, and all exhibits referenced and attached hereto are incorporated

herein and made a specific part of this resolution.

SECTION 2: The City Commission HEREBY awards RFQ No. 19-26Q to CPZ Architects, Inc., and approves an Agreement between the City of Tamarac and CPZ Architects, Inc. (“The Agreement”) and the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement, hereto attached as “Exhibit 2”, for the design of Sunset Point / Veterans Park Renovations, at a contract cost of \$258,705.00, a contingency in the amount of \$25,870.50 (10% of the contract cost) will be added to the project account, for a total project budget of \$284,575.50.

SECTION 3: An expenditure in the amount of \$258,705.00, a contingency in the amount of \$25,870.50 (10% of the contract cost) will be added to the project account, for a total project budget of \$284,575.50 is HEREBY approved.

SECTION 4: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

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SECTION 6: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
