Commission Meeting of July 8, 2020

Recommendation:

I recommend that the City Commission approve a Resolution approving the Construction Agreement ("Agreement") between Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and the City of Tamarac, for the installation of an Emergency Traffic Signal System at Fire Station 36; and authorizing the appropriate City Officials to execute said Agreement; and that this item be placed on the July 8, 2020 Commission Agenda.

<u>lssue:</u>

FDOT requires the City of Tamarac to enter into a Construction Agreement for the Emergency Traffic Signal to be installed within the State Right-of-Way at Fire Station 36.

Background:

The City of Tamarac has proposed the installation of an Emergency Traffic Signal within the right-of-way of North University Drive and NW 72nd Street. As the proposed Emergency Traffic Signal will be located, at least partially, within the State Right-of-Way, Florida Department of Transportation requires the City to execute a Construction Agreement.

The Construction Agreement is required for the Emergency Vehicle System to be installed and is critical for the timely completion of the project.
