A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TAMARAC, FLORIDA ACCEPTING A BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE (BJA) FY20 CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING PROGRAM GRANT (CESF) THROUGH THE US DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (DOJ) OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS (OJP) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,795.00 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TAMARAC TO SERVE AS THE LEAD AGENCY; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TAMARAC AND OJP PENDING LEGAL REVIEW; EXECUTING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN THE CITY OF TAMARAC AND THE BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE (BSO) PENDING LEGAL REVIEW FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF BJA CORONAVIRUS GRANT FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Tamarac desires to protect the health and wellbeing of the residents, citizens, businesses and visitors of the City of Tamarac from the coronavirus pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Tamarac desires to protect law enforcement, first responders and City staff from the coronavirus pandemic, and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) provides a supplemental grant program providing funding to municipalities for personal protective equipment (PPE) and other coronavirus disinfecting supplies and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tamarac received notice it was approved for an FY20 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Program (CESF) grant award for both the City of Tamarac and the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) in the amount of \$36,795.<sup>00</sup> as

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indicated on the FY20 DOJ BJA Award Report attached HERETO as Exhibit A and incorporated HEREIN by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tamarac agrees to serve as lead agency to provide for the administration of the FY20 CESF Program grant funds between the City of Tamarac and the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO); and

WHEREAS, the Interim Director of Financial Services and BSO Tamarac District Commander recommend acceptance of the FY20 CESF Program grant award and approval of the above referenced MOU that is attached HERETO as Exhibit B and incorporated HEREIN by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Tamarac, Florida, deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Tamarac to accept the FY20 CESF Program grant award and authorize the appropriate City Officials to approve and execute an MOU and necessary documents pending legal review for the FY20 CESF Program grant award between the City of Tamarac and BSO; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Tamarac, Florida, agrees to serve as lead agency providing for the administration of the FY20 CESF Program grant award for BSO and the City of Tamarac.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TAMARAC, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are HEREBY ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are HEREBY made a specific part of this Resolution. All exhibits attached HERETO are incorporated HEREIN and made a specific part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The City Commission of the City of Tamarac HEREBY accepts the FY20 BJA Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Program (CESF) grant award in the

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amount of \$36,795.<sup>00</sup> and approves the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and necessary documents between the City of Tamarac and the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) for the administration of the FY20 CESF Program grant pending legal review.

SECTION 3: The City of Tamarac is HEREBY authorized to serve as the lead agency and provide for the administration of the FY20 CESF Program grant award.

SECTION 4: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are HEREBY repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: If any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

SECTION 6: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
